Presbytery Prayers

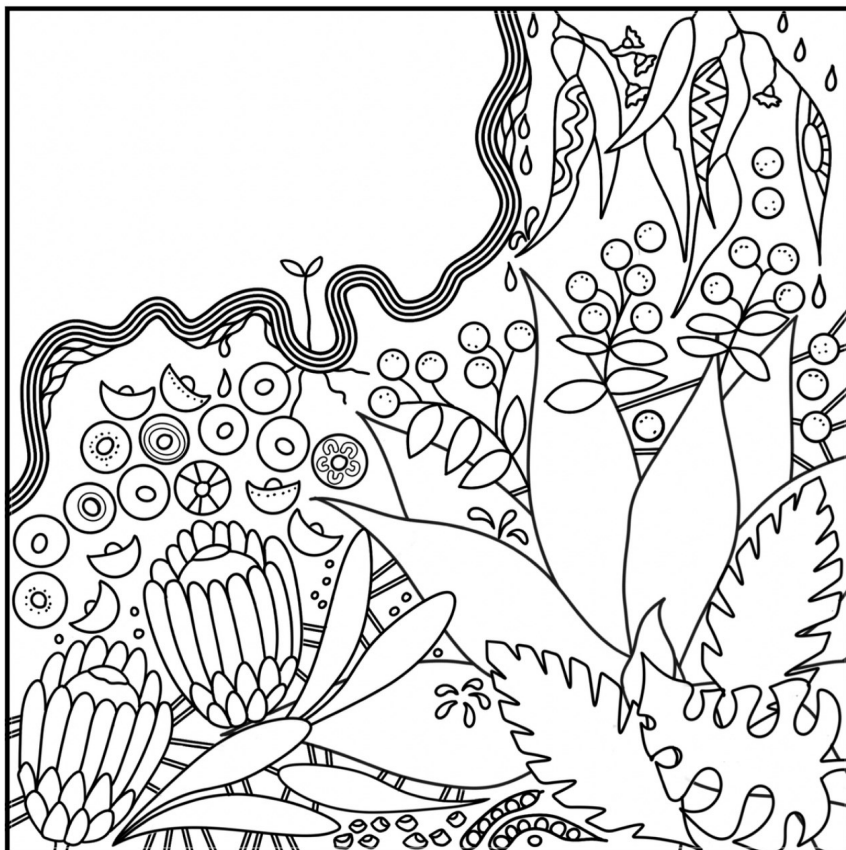
