Rev. Ross Writes...

The Gospel reading for this week may seem old fashioned or irrelevant to some, "Why are we talking about demon possession, we don't believe in that stuff anymore." But the history and atrocities of the 20th century show that not everything can be written off as mental illness or psychological disorder. There is evil in the world; forces and attitudes that work against life, against truth, and against community. And the wondrous part of Mark's little story is Jesus' reaction. Not power, or force, or rejection, but release from evil and freedom for the person. That is who we worship.

The great battle of good and evil still rages.

We think we have it tamed through science and psychology,

but people are still gripped by demons.

Impulses and desires and drives that go beyond human;

doubts and nagging thoughts that resist reason.

We can rename the demons

as collective unconscious.

or zeitgeist,

or cultural hangovers,

or wishful thinking to avoid blame,

or mental illness;

but it is still the great battle of good and evil.

And Jesus the Christ is our great warrior;

the One who accepts, releases, and renews,

the One who commands the demons and frees the sufferer.

Psychology is good, therapy is freeing, knowledge is power,

but true freedom and true humanity come through prayer.


