

Rev. Ross Writes...

In the early 90's there was a book released called "The Seven Last Words of Christ" which looked at the cross from the words recorded in the four Gospels. In 2006, Shane Stanford produced this book looking at the words of Jesus after the resurrection. The dominant words in this vear's Lectionary selections - both last week and this week – are **Peace be with you.** This is so much more than the simple cultural greeting of 'shalom'. And it is more than "Do not be afraid". This is Jesus saying to the disciples, "In the midst of your grief and confusion, your doubt and guilt; Peace be with you. I am here, let my presence calm your minds and calm your hearts."

But, of course, that peace was far from a simple matter. We can only guess at the

strong, almost overwhelming emotions surging through the disciples. The stories, in both Luke and John, have details of the reassurance needed to bring them to peace. The resurrection isn't such an emotion charged subject for many of us, but there are many issues and experiences in our lives where we need to hear the voice of our Risen Lord, "Peace be with you. Let my presence calm your mind and calm your heart." In this complex, ever-changing world, may you know the peace that Jesus brings.
