## Rev. Ross Writes...

### **The ANZAC Tradition**



The tradition – courage, determination, and mateship – began on April 25, 1915, when, in support of the Empire, soldiers of the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps landed on the Gallipoli Peninsula. It was meant to be a grand plan to take Turkey out of the war and open access to the Black Sea.

In seriously underestimating Turkey, it was a failure. But the failure didn't wipe out the determination; in that terrible, 8-month long campaign, the men created the notion of a special spirit and added the word ANZAC to our vocabulary. Despite that campaign ending in retreat, April 25 was inaugurated as a remembrance of service and loss of life as early as 1916 and commemorated as such even by front line troops in France and Egypt.

Remembrance Day is about peace and ending wars, ANZAC Day is about honouring the men and women who fought wars in our name. We remember before God all who, in the Great War - the war that was supposed to end wars - and in all following wars and subsequent conflicts down to today, have taken up arms under the name ANZAC. We remember particularly those who gave their lives in defence of freedom and justice; those listed on walls and memorials and those listed in our hearts.

### **Welcome**

It is a joy to welcome new people into our community. Those who have found their place before God with us. A sign of the ongoing call of the Spirit and continuing relevance of communities of faith in people's lives.

Take the time to greet and welcome and share with people each week, particularly someone you haven't talked to before, for that is what gathering as a community is all about.

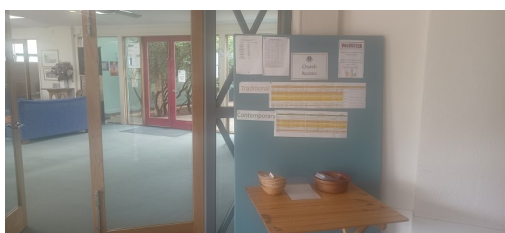
