There will be a new edition of High Street Times delivered next week which will contain an article about the principles that we will follow around opening for any gatherings, the range of issues that will need to be addressed, and the formation of a small group to oversee our safe response to the hazards of Covid-19. The safety of all people and the good of the whole community are very high in our concerns; we will not be returning to large gatherings in a single physical space for some time yet, though we will continue to make use of what means we have for staying connected and reaching out, in the grace and love of God.

This week's Bible reading, following the Narrative Lectionary, is about hope, and the particular promise of the defeat of death through the resurrection of Jesus. Paul writes of his own experience of the risen Jesus, which turned him from being a persecutor of the church to being a chief advocate, and he writes of the many others who were early witnesses of Jesus' resurrection. The promise of the renewal of all the world, which is held in God's eternal embrace, gives strength to Paul to be steadfast in hope and to encourage us to "always excel in the work of the Lord, because you know that in the Lord your labour is not in vain." (1 Corinthians 15:58)

Perhaps the glimpses that we see of the green life in the garden when the sun breaks out after rain will be a context of our thanks for the life and the promise that God nurtures inside of us.
