Dear friends,

Having school-aged children I tend to be very conscious of the rhythms of the school term, and this term has been a pretty hard slog – particularly for the kids. The lockdown has been long, though we're starting to see some light at the end of the tunnel as the vaccination numbers keep climbing. As I walked this morning I set aside my usual prayer podcast, to focus on listening for God in the context of the bird-calls and the plentiful signs of spring.

For some, the next two weeks will be "business as usual". For others, it will be more complicated than usual with kids not having any school activities. For some like me, it will be a time for family together without the usual school and work pressures – a kind of Sabbath rest.

This week we continue our reading of James's letter about practical Christianity. Our reading today is about wisdom which is recognised "in the way you live, not the way you talk" (using the MESSAGE translation). The author of this letter could be the same James who helped to broker agreements between early Christians (mostly Jewish) who believed that the Jewish laws and customs should be followed by Gentile Christians, and others (led by the Jewish teacher, Paul) who did not think that Gentile Christians should be burdened that way (see Acts 15: 12-21; 21:17-26). James' wisdom is on display in those efforts towards reconciliation and peace.

Next week will be the last week of the series, in which practical Christianity is rounded out with prayer, faith, and care for one another in community.
