Banners and Liturgical Colours—What does it mean?

If you read this article before you get to Church or after you get home, what colour was the Banner at the front of the Church? It was green and it's been green for quite a while. Next week it will be white and the week after it will be purple. What's going on?

Green, white, purple and red are the four liturgical colours. Each colour stands for a particular Season in the Christian Church's Year. The different colours point to the seasons behind them.

Here are the different colours and the seasons to which they point.

PURPLE (or VIOLET): The Church's Year begins with Advent with the four Sundays before Christmas Day. This year it will begin on the 3rd December. Advent is a time of preparation to enable faithful Christians to celebrate the birth of the Saviour Jesus.

PURPLE is also used for Lent. Lent is the season of 40 days (not including Sundays) leading up to Easter. Lent is also a time of preparation. But it is different and more penitential in that Lent is a period of grief anticipating the Crucifixion of Jesus that ends with a great celebration of Easter.

<u>WHITE:</u> White is used for any day or period of celebration that involves Jesus Christ. These include the obvious times of Christmas and Easter. But they also include the Season of Epiphany, Jesus' Baptism, Jesus' Transfiguration, Trinity Sunday, All Saints Day and the Feast of Christ the King (26th November this year).

<u>**RED:**</u> Red is used on the Day of Pentecost when the Book of Acts tells us of flames alighting on the heads of the followers of Jesus 50 days after his crucifixion.

<u>GREEN:</u> Green is associated with growth. There is a small season of Epiphany—to show forth Jesus to the world which follows the 6th January—the day of Epiphany—up until the Sunday before Lent on which we choose to celebrate the Transfiguration. The longer season of growth begins after Trinity Sunday (which is the Sunday after Pentecost) and last about 6 months. It is a period of sustained growth for Christians as the Lectionary readings cover much of scripture.
