On the evening of Easter day, Jesus appeared to the disciples who were locked away for fear of the Jews. Can you imagine how they felt when they saw him and he said, "Peace be with you"? Then he breathed on them, "Receive the Holy Spirit." Thomas missed out on this profound community moment. When he heard about what he had missed, he expressed his concerns; and raised questions about it.

A week later, when Thomas was with the disciples, Jesus appeared to them again and once more said, "Peace be with you." Then he spoke to Thomas, "Put your finger here and see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." Thomas, seeing Jesus resurrected yet still wounded body, says, "My Lord and my God."

Today, as we worship, we will explore this idea: that all people, all of us, can live a full and 'risen' life while still wounded. As Richard Rohr affirms life is about death and resurrection, not death or resurrection. It is good that you are here. Welcome.


