Dear friends,

We have just had a very stimulating Church Council meeting, talking about ministry and mission planning for this year and beyond. Perhaps the most immediately exciting decision was that the May Fete can go ahead, on Saturday 8 May. Clearly this is relatively short notice, and there are COVID safety requirements that will need to be met, but after a long time between Fetes this will be a very welcome return!

Our Bible readings this weekend are focused on Jesus appearing to his disciples, making it clear to them that he is “not a ghost!” and commissioning them for the proclamation of God’s grace and peace. During our services we’ll use the call and response: “The peace of the Lord be with you”, “And also with you”. We still can’t go from person to person and offer such greetings, but whether you are present in person or over zoom/phones we will pray that peace for each other. We will commission the members of Church Council, Elders and the Contemporary Oversight Group. As part of the service, they will be invited to offer the greeting of peace to the congregation, and to be reassured by the congregation’s response. Then, together, we can embody our care for the world, since we are not ghosts, either!
