is delighted to invite you to a special musical event!



The Back Page...

LET THE SAME MIND BE IN YOU...

This week's reading is Philippians 2:1-13. Encouraging us to avoid conceit but, in humility, look to the best interests of others, It includes the wonderful passage about Christ's humility:

though equal with God,

he emptied himself to become human;

and in human form, humbled himself;

being obedient to the point of death,

even death on the cross...

therefore,

God exalted him

giving him a name higher than all names

so that all should acknowledge and confess

that Jesus Christ is Lord!

The conclusion drawn in the text from this is that we should not be arrogant, but rather "work out our own salvation with fear and trembling". After all, no disciple is greater than their master, so if their master serves humbly in the interests of others, the disciple should behave similarly.

Last week we heard Paul's confident assurance that God will follow through on the good work God has begun in us. It is repeated in this passage, lest we think that working out our salvation means that it is all up to us. Thanks be to God, "for it is God who is at work in you, enabling you both to will and to work for his good pleasure." And we'll hear more about that at Pentecost!
