High Street Uniting Church is well known in the Frankston Community for the way that our love for God translates into practical care and involvement in the local community.

That care and involvement includes Operation Larder, which provides food and basic supplies for the disadvantaged; the provision of an outreach chaplain to Monash University Peninsula Campus; a weekly lunch for the homeless and disadvantaged; Voices of Frankston; support for chaplaincy at Frankston High School and support for community groups who meet in our buildings.

We also provide support to a number of international projects, particularly in East Timor and India.



Our regular giving, as well as bequests and donations to the church, Larder and Voices of Frankston, enables our ministry of strengthening community, embracing all people, and connecting younger generations in God's love. In 2018 we have commenced a Pastoral Care Coordination role and a Youth Coordinator role, devoting resources to building up the people around us as a part of responding to the vision for our ministry in Christ's name.
