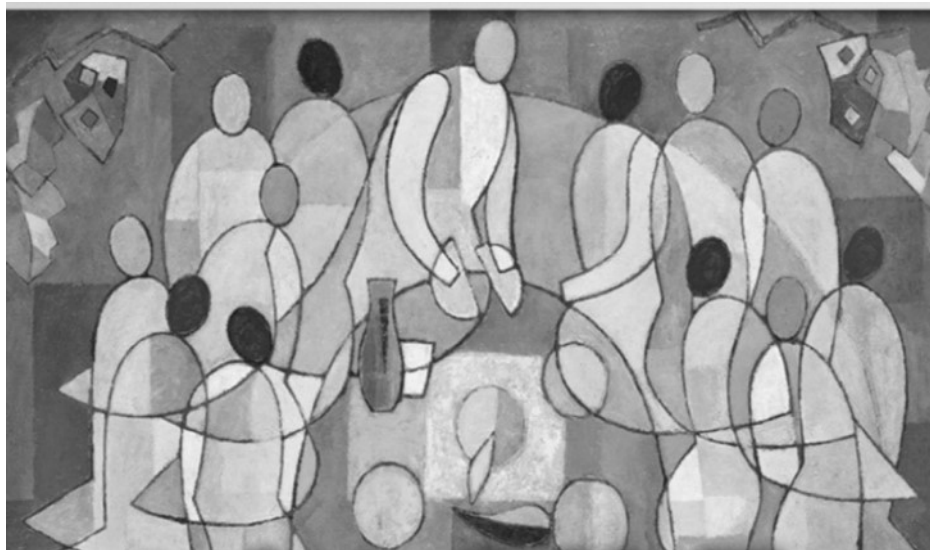

David will be on 5 weeks of leave (26 August until the end of September). During that time, Arthur Poole will be the contact person in case of urgent pastoral need.

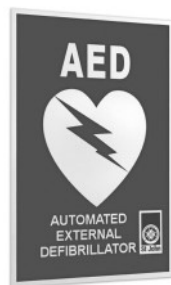
Walkie Talkies Saturday
