Max's great granddaughter Quinn was baptised at High Street Uniting Church in 2018, also being a great granddaughter to Mac and Anne Cleland. # **COVID SAFETY OVERSIGHT GROUP**

The High Street Uniting Church Covid Safety Oversight Group continues to meet regularly to further our preparedness for the use of the buildings. We have rearranged the pews to accommodate 50 people with the required social distancing. Jacqui is not yet working from the office, though she does monitor emails and the phone. Being limited to having no more than 1 person per 4 square metres it is important to note that there can be no more than **2 people in the reception office area** at any time. The Ministry Team room has the same limit. The Hall is limited to 32 people, the Back Hall 15, the Blue Room 11 and the Green Room 8. The Church is limited to just over 50. We have prepared some protocols for groups that wish to hire or use spaces again, including taking a short online course about infection control, and we will require them to sign their agreement to the necessary conditions. We will be making hand sanitiser readily available, and regulating the flow of people to avoid cross-overs in doorways – so, at present, the normal entrance door from the car park will be "IN ONLY", and exit

will be through the doors in the foyer nearer to the toilets. These and all other protocols will continue to be reviewed over time. As considerable cleaning is required after every group, we will normally allow only one group per room per day, with cleaning overnight. With these protocols in place, we may begin seeing some small groups returning soon.
