This week the Church Council met and discussed a number of matters pertinent to the life of the community. We established a Local Community Outreach Working Group, to be convened by Jackie Annable, to help us to engage in local community care which is valuable, sustainable, and safe against contagion. We agreed that worship will continue for now in its current form, recognising that we miss times of physical gathering, but thankful that so many are able to participate in worship in this way, including people who otherwise would not be able to because of distance or mobility.

We noted that our offerings are running at about 85% of the originally budgeted amount. In other circumstances, this Sunday would have been "Planned Giving Sunday", with an opportunity for everyone to consider their giving for the coming year. With current government supplements, Hannah on Maternity Leave and Jacqui on reduced hours our budget is OK at the moment; we are working on a forecast budget for the rest of the year, albeit with a large number of variables! Many people have made extra efforts to continue to set aside offerings physically or to make offerings through direct transfers – thank you! All of these efforts and the offerings you are able to share are blessings. Thank you for your consideration of how you are able to provide for the ministry of the church as this year continues to unfold.
